

### Jinku (Sumo Folk Songs)

Sumo Jinku are special folk songs consisting of 4 parts. Parts 1-3 are 7 syllables long and part 4 has 5 syllables.

## Shokkiri (Sumo Slapstick Comedy Show)

A sumo slapstick comedy show explaining and demonstrating various techniques, rules, as well as illegal moves.

## Kamiyui Oicho

A hairdresser demonstrates making a topknot (Oicho), worn only by Rikishi who are Juryo level or above.
